In Western Christianity, Ash Wednesday marks the first day, or the start of the Season of Lent, which begins 40 days prior to Easter

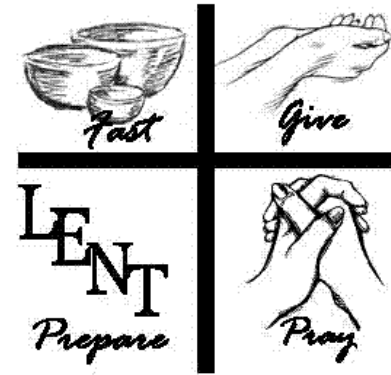
(Sundays not included in the count).
