## ***The Liturgical Season of Epiphany***

Beginning with the Epiphany (Sunday) of our Lord and going on to the Sundays that follow, Christ's manifestation of Himself to the world is traced out through His public ministry and miracles. The Epiphany Season celebrates the many ways that Christ made Himself known to the world. The word "Epiphany" originates from the Greek word "epiphainen." It is a verb that means "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known."
