What we need most:

Canned food

- Soups

- Fruit
- Meat/fish (tuna, chicken, ham)
- Canned Beans

- Juice (I or 2 L)
- Coffee (ground), not flavoured
- Tea (herbal, regular)

Dry Goods

- Pasta (375, 500, 900 g or large)
- Kraft Dinner
- Rice
- Peanut Butter (500, 750 g)
- Jam (300, 500 g)
- Cereal, hot or cold (large)
- Meal in a can (ravioli, stew)
